Rotation Goals and Objectives

Visiting residents will work with our three fellows, who will help guide case assignments based on the resident's interest and experience. Residents will assist with coverage of inpatient and ED consults during the day, and will take one night of home call per week. They will participate in the scheduled didactic activities for the fellowship (M+M, tumor board, case conference, FMIGS lectures). All residents will present a topic of their choice to the faculty during their rotation; they will also be given the opportunity to edit and submit a surgical video to a national conference.

Program Description

High-volume surgical practice in Seattle, Washington, with a well-established FMIGS. Faculty are three FMIGS-trained surgeons and two gynecologic oncologists; there is an opportunity to work with a reproductive endocrinologist as well.
