Description of Program:

This two-year program will provide fellows with dedicated surgical experience, outpatient clinical experience in pre-and post-operative patient care, protected administrative time, and protected didactic time. Fellowship Year 1 will be dedicated to mastery of fundamental principles of advanced gynecologic surgery focusing on vaginal, hysteroscopic, laparoscopic, and robotic surgery. We anticipate that second year fellows will be assigned to the more complex of these cases. Blocks will consist of 4-8 week rotations. In addition, fellows will also have 4 weeks of vacation per year to be distributed in between blocks. The UCLA Department of ObGyn supports a trainee-run, multi-specialty continuity clinic on campus dedicated to providing excellent care to underinsured patients. This clinic provides care in general obstetrics and gynecology, as well as other sub-specialties including Maternal Fetal Medicine, Gynecologic Oncology, Reproductive Endocrinology, Family Planning, and Pelvic Pain. As part of their clinical experience, we will be coordinating with clinic directors to develop dedicated Minimally Invasive Gynecologic Surgery consultation time in this clinic. Under supervision of the Core Faculty, this will allow fellows to work with residents in performing surgical consultations and providing preoperative evaluations with postoperative follow-up. Fellow will have dedicated outpatient experience with our MIGS trained endometriosis/pelvic pain specialists in focused in outpatient management including advanced ultrasound techniques and procedural pelvic pain management. Further, this clinic will provide additional opportunities for mastery of office-based procedures required for fellowship completion. Fellows will be expected to attend an average of one half-session per week of continuity clinic.
